YTD profit is currently 37% (\$435K) ahead of budget and currently the 2023 profit is ahead of last year's budget by 18% (\$181,748). The 2nd Quarter generated more room revenue than any previous 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarters. The Audit is almost complete.

**Insurance Update** Rick Toland of the Richard's Group has provided information on Board insurance coverage and pricing. Our renewal date is October 1, 2023.

**F&B Capital Renovation Update** Matt Holland talked about the deficiencies in the current kitchen. Need more linear space for food preparation. Need refrigerator space for food, beer, and keg storage. Change flooring and rebuild sub-flooring. Replace/repair the drain system. By increasing space by 100 square feet, the kitchen would be more efficient. \$\$\$

Break for lunch. Reconvened at 1:38 p.m. **Solar Project Update** Jeff McIver reported that the solar panels are installed and delivery of the transformer is expected soon. The company is willing to reimburse us for energy savings during the delivery delay.

**Patio Update** Don Damon reported that we still have not gotten approval from the town of Lincoln to build the patio.

**Assistant General Manager's Report** Mike Simons reported that the unit forfeited for back dues and fees was sold at Market Price. Presently a few dues delinquencies still exist, but are being managed.
